Spin Pack Change Operator

Job Purpose: To efficiently and effectively manage the extrusion process converting plastic flake into fiber

Job Duties:

- Perform scheduled filter changes

Feeding Operator

- Feed fiber through rollers to align with the rest of the fiber from other sections of the line
- Ensure sprayers are on and coating fiber with correct liquids
- Monitor rollers to ensure fiber is not wrapping, causing stoppage
- Monitor controls on speed and tightness
- General housekeeping duties along the lines

- Wind the fiber correctly around the rollers, and through the baths, ensuring even flow through the roller process
- Monitor fiber when running through the line, ensuring texture is correct and flow into crimp is correct
- If fiber wraps on rollers, must be able to quickly attack the problem, cutting the fiber from the incorrect side of the roller, stopping the wrap
- If the wrap is too full and tight, will need to cut out all fiber, then pull fiber through the rollers connecting two pieces together to continue operation.
- · Ensure solutions in baths are mixed and flowing as required
- Keep knives available and in correct location/section of the line for quick access
- Pick up all wasted fiber from the area, loading into supersacks to later be taken to reprocess.
- Keep water/oil/solution puddles squeegeed ensuring floors are safe and free from potential slips
